ALERT: 67th Annual CASBO Conference & Exhibits Cancelled

Dear CASBO Members and Annual Conference Guests,

This letter is to inform you that the 67th Annual CASBO Conference & Exhibits, scheduled for April 15 through 17, 2020 in Westminster, has been cancelled. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and other agencies have expressed growing concern about the spread of COVID-19 in the United States, particularly with respect to large events and mass gatherings. On March 15th, the CDC issued Guidance in which it recommends that “for the next 8 weeks, organizers (whether groups or individuals) cancel or postpone in-person events that consist of 50 people or more throughout the United States.”

The health and safety of our members, conference guests, and staff is always a priority for us. Given the CDC’s Guidance, we believe that it is impossible for us to go forward with the Conference in response to this health emergency beyond our control.

Please accept my sincere and heartfelt apology for any inconvenience. Further information will be forthcoming regarding next steps in this process with respect to registration fees.
